English

- Read the story in John chapter 6 verses 1–15 and follow along using the Jesus Feeds the 5000 Powerpoint.
- Encourage writing skills by re-telling the story using the Jesus Feeds the 5000 Writing Frames.
- Write a letter home from the perspective of the boy in the story using the Jesus Feeds the 5000 Story Page Borders.
- Create and act out a drama. The narrator could use the Jesus Feeds the 5000 Story Script, or write his/her own.

Art & Design:

 Create a mural of the story to display on a wall and draw yourselves in it. Use The Loaves and Fishes Story Cut Outs for the main characters.

STEM

- Use the **Bread Recipe Sheet** to bake your own loaves of bread.
- Calculate how much of today's money it would take to feed dinner to 5000 people. Would it still be more than half a year's wages?
- Visualise the number in the story by challenging the group to gather and count 5000 beans, pieces of cereal, etc. Use Thousands Hundreds Tens And Units Place Value Sliders to help keep count.

Christian Education

- Discuss: In this story, Jesus invites people to help him make a miracle happen. Who are the participants in the story who get to be a part of the miracle? Each of them needed to trust Jesus and have faith- and because they did, 5000 people got to experience the miracle! In what ways can we show people our faith in Jesus today?
- Pray: Dear God, Help us to trust in You and have faith, so that you can do amazing things through us. Amen.
- Memory verse: John chapter 6 verse 9. Use John 6-9 Mindfulness Coloring Page to help students learn this week's memory verse.
- Quiet Time: Use the Jesus Feeds the 5000 Journal Page to reflect individually.
